### National Commander Clarence Hill's "I met T.H.E. Job Challenge" Pin

During the 2009-2010 membership year, National Commander Clarence Hill will award his National Commander Pin to any Legion family member who signs up at least five new members. A new member is defined as any eligible person joining for the 2010 membership year who was not a member during the 2009 membership year.

Commander Hill's goal is to recognize those in the Legion family who actively recruit new members. To maintain the integrity of the National Commander's Pin incentive program, only one will be awarded per individual.

The certification form may be submitted at any time after Aug. 27, 2009. Upon receipt, national membership staff will confirm the names and mail the pin directly to the Legionnaire. Commander Hill's "I met T.H.E. Job Challenge" pin incentive will end June 30, 2010, or when pin supplies are exhausted.
