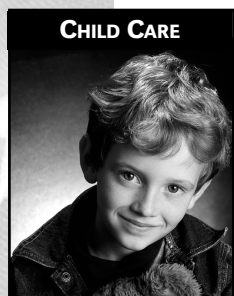

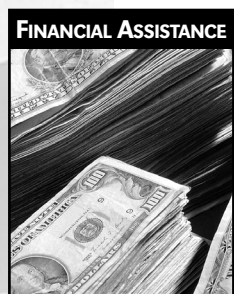
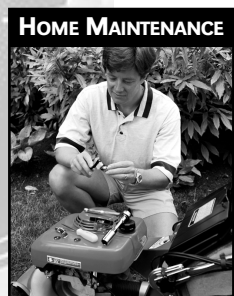
When You Go Into Action ...
