A BILL

Be it enacted by The American Legion Boys Nation Senate assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "This Act may be cited as the "Twenty-Two Act―".

SECTION 2. (1) Course could teach students how to handle hardships, deaths, and depression

- (2) A standardized "Wellness" test that measures the mental health of a student could be sufficient enough to stopping a potential suicide
- (3) Act would implement counseling to students and motivate them to direct their issues into something else like sports
- (4) Class would inform individuals about mental health stigmas and complications in America

- (5) Promotes healthy practices
- (6) Act would allow students with "over abundance of stress" have wellness breaks from school that won't count against them
- (7) Act will decrease suicides and/or self harm with minors
- (8) Promotes recovery and treatment
