John C. Lawrence (LA) - Bio National Vice Commander Southeast Region

John C. Lawrence is a National Vice Commander representing the Southeast Region. He hails from the great state of Louisiana, where he has been a lifelong resident of the New Orleans area. John has been a member of the Sons of the American Legion for the past 23 years. John's eligibility comes from his grandfather, Cyprian Anthony Sidora, who served in the US Army during WWII from June 27, 1945, to December 14, 1945, and his father, Conrad John Lawrence, who served in the Louisiana Army National Guard.

John has served the Sons in many positions at local, state, and national levels, including his current positions as the Detachment of Louisiana's alternate National Executive Committeeman since 2018 and vice chairman of the National Children & Youth Committee since 2016. John is also the current Commander of Bayhi-Ravey Squadron 329 since its inception in 2021 and was instrumental in establishing the charter.

John has served the national organization as a member of the Americanism Commission for two years and the Children & Youth Committee for six years. He also served with the Louisiana detachment as commander from 2015 to 2018, vice commander from 2013 to 2015, assistant adjutant in 2013, Americanism chairman, internal affairs chairman, and constitution and by-laws chairman. He also previously served as the squadron commander of squadrons 218 and 64.

In 2018, John completed the SAL National Management Institute's commanders', NEC, and adjutant training in Indianapolis.
