Scholarships

**Applications due
March 1st**

- **Children of Warriors National Presidents' Scholarship**
 - 15 - \$5,000 scholarships
 - Must be a direct descendant of a veteran who served during The American Legion's eligibility dates
 - Must be a senior in high school
 - Must complete 50 hours of volunteer service during high school
 - Must complete an essay question
- **Spirit of Youth Scholarship**
 - 5 - \$5,000 scholarships
 - Up to 47 \$1,000 scholarships
 - Must be a member of the American Legion Auxiliary for the past 3 years plus the current membership year
 - Must be a senior in high school
 - Must display active involvement with the ALA
 - Must complete an essay question
