 Youth should demonstrate leadership in community service.







# **Scholarships**

# Applications due March 1st

#### Children of Warriors National Presidents' Scholarship

- 15 \$5,000 scholarships
- Must be a direct descendant of a veteran who served during The American Legion's eligibility dates
- Must be a senior in high school
- Must complete 50 hours of volunteer service during high school
- Must complete an essay question

#### Spirit of Youth Scholarship

- 5 \$5,000 scholarships
- Up to 47 \$1,000 scholarships
- Must be a member of the American Legion Auxiliary for the past 3 years plus the current membership year
- Must be a senior in high school
- Must display active involvement with the ALA
- Must complete an essay question
