

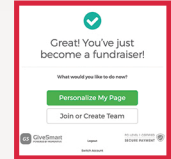

Become a Fundraiser

1. Go to the sign-up form at legion.org/LegacyRunP2P or **scan this qr code**
2. Complete the form
3. Click Become a Fundraiser



Personalize Your Page

You can personalize your fundraising page by adding a photo of yourself, setting your personal fundraising goal and writing a personal message. Be sure to click **SAVE** after you have made any changes to ensure those changes are retained.

1. You can initially personalize your fundraising page by clicking the **Personalize My Page** button after signing up.
2. Click on the **Edit My Page** button from the email you received when you signed up. This method recognizes the email and doesn't require a password to go to the editor. *(Be sure to keep the email for future reference.)*



Create or Join a Team

To join or create a team simply click the **Edit My Page** button from the email you received when you signed up and click on the **Join** or **Create Team** button. This will direct you to a page where you can search for and join a team that has already been created or create your own.

Some examples of teams are:

Teams are a great way to bring a level of interactivity and engagement to your fundraising campaign. They add another level of participation and competition between volunteer fundraisers. Donations to fundraisers who are members of teams will count toward their personal goals as well as the goals of the team.

Personalizing Your Team Page

Similar to personalizing your fundraising page you can personalize the team page with a team image, custom carousel images and team message. This can be completed at the time you create your team or it can be edited by the fundraiser that created the team by going to the team page and clicking the **Edit My Page** button in the right-hand corner of the page footer. *(Additional verification may be required to edit the page.)*
