


HISTORIC VIRGINIA CITY TOUR


HISTORIC DONNER-TRUCKEE TOUR

As a crossroads of Western History, the Donner - Truckee area is rich in pioneer lore. For untold centuries, Native Americans camped along the forested shores of Donner Lake and the high flat of Martis Plateau. This was the route of westward-bound emigrants who struggled with their wagons over the rugged Sierra passes. Chinese coolies blasted tunnels through the granite mountains as Irishmen laid down the miles of iron rails for the Transcontinental Railroad in the late 1860's. A visit will be made to Donner Memorial Historic Park and its fine museum. It was here during the winter of 1846-47 that members of the famous westward-bound "Donner Party" played out their tragic rendezvous with destiny.

See why Northern Nevada is like no other place on Earth, with its big city excitement, and small town hospitality. This city tour will provide a bit of history on the, "The Biggest Little City in the World," including a stop at the famous **Reno Arch** and some time in **Wingfield Park** along the Truckee River to view the "whispering giant" and the beautiful rose gardens. You will get a taste of Reno's growing craft beer scene at "**The Depot**" - a historical train station built to serve as the head quarters of the Nevada-California-Oregon Railway in 1910, and now beautifully restored into Nevada's first combined brewery and distillery.

Our final stop is the **National Automobile Museum**. The museum is billed as the most comprehensive public display of automobiles in the Western Hemisphere, and presents a fine array of vehicles from the 1890's up nearly to the present. The exhibits take the form of four recreated streets, one representing each quarter of the 20th century. Each display room contains approximately 50 cars apiece. Vehicles are arranged on gravel roads with paths meandering through.
