HONORING THOSE WHO SACRIFICED MOST



The American Legion Legacy Scholarship provides needs-based scholarships for eligible children of veterans.

WHO

There are two groups of eligible recipients. First, children of U.S. military members who died while on active duty on or after Sept. 11, 2001. Children of post-9/11 veterans with a VA-rated 50 percent or higher disability also qualify.

WHAT

Each needs-based scholarship provides up to \$20,000 in aid for undergraduate or post-graduate college. These are designed to fill the financial aid gap after all federal and state aid options are exhausted. Recipients may reapply for additional awards up to six times.

WHEN

The application deadline is April 20, and the scholarship awards must be used within one year.
