Mr. Brazanskas of District Of Columbia introduced the following bill;

A BILL

Establishing the District of Columbia as the 51st state in the United States of America, with appropriate congresspeople, and ending their era of taxation without representation.

Be it enacted by The American Legion Boys Nation Senate assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "act for D.C. Statehood".

SECTION 2.

Henceforth, Washington D.C. will be indoctrinated into the Union of the United states of America as the 51st state, and will operate as one similar to their state counterparts. This state shall now be called New Columbia and will also posses two elected Senators and an Elected House Member for their one district. The Mayor of New Columbia will now play the double role and serve as governor additionally.
