Recognizing Allied Nations

Whereas military alliances with foreign and domestic Native American nations have been instrumental in improving the success and duration of United States military ventures, including France during the Revolutionary War, France and the United Kingdom during both World Wars, and the United Kingdom during the Afghan and Iraq wars.

Whereas the continued security of our global freedom is enslaved through ongoing alliances with foreign nations including the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO), the Rio Pact, and the Combined Maritime Forces (CMF)

Whereas several foreign nations have donated gifts that beautified our country as a gesture of peace and diplomacy including the Statue of Liberty from France, the cherry trees from Japan, two Pandas from China, and the senate gavel from India.

Whereas the United States has collaborated with several nations during initiatives to protect humanity

and the health of the global environment, including the United Nations, Climate talks, and G8 summits.

Whereas the United States has improved the standard of living and access to goods for its residents and globally through the World Trade Organization (WTO) and agreements with other countries including the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) with 20 individual nations such as Costa Rica and Singapore
