Mr. Cecil of Idaho introduced the following bill;

## A BILL

Calling for the removal of federal funding for National and International abortions. This does not inhibit a woman's right to choose, but is instead stating that it is not the job of the Federal Government to finance elective medical procedures.

*Be it enacted by The American Legion Boys Nation Senate assembled,*

### SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "Ending government funded abortions".

### SECTION 2.

There is hereby appropriated, that all federal funding for abortions nationally and internationally is to be stopped, and the money is to be placed in the national treasury to be used for other such purposes as needed. Such an act is needed to--

- (1) Reduce spending from the national treasury on non-necessary programs, so that said funding

can be applied to other more critical programs.

(2) This is in no way prohibiting a woman's right to choose, but instead saying that it is not the job of the government to support and persuade a woman, what she should do with her own body.

(3) Such funding from the government can imply that they would rather see a woman kill her own child, then have it be born. Such ideals could have major repercussions, which is why funding for this program must stop immediately.

(4) Regardless of political view, this program is spending huge amounts of money, not only in our country but many other countries. This money should be used to help people that really need it, and not those that are not in a life-threatening situation.

(5) Those who have been victims of sexual assault, rape, and incest will still be eligible for said funding.

### **SECTION 3.**

Appropriations funds made available and authority granted pursuant to this Act shall be available until whichever of the following first occurs:

(1) Until federal law changes in regards to the legality of abortion, in which case funding for other victims of sexual assault, rape, and incest would cease.
