Mr. Hu of Massachusetts introduced the following bill;

## A BILL

Legalizing and Instituting Euthanasia on a national level, ensuring that every American has a right to a peaceful death.

*Be it enacted by The American Legion Boys Nation Senate assembled,*

### SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "This act may be cited as the "Legalizing and Instituting Federal Euthanasia Act (L.I.F.E.) Act".

### SEC. 2. DEFINITION

"Euthanasia" refers to the act or practice of painlessly putting to death persons suffering from a painful and incurable disease or incapacitating physical disorder or allowing them to die by withholding treatment or withdrawing artificial life-support measures. There should be no crime in dying with dignity.

### SECTION 3. IMPLEMENTATION OF EUTHANASIA

All acts of euthanasia, based on the definition, shall now be made legal by federal law in the United States, regardless of citizenship.

A) Hospitals and health clinics shall be provided with adequate euthanasia training guides to better facilitate the process through the Department of Health and Human Services.

B) All those who are not medically diagnosed by a professional medical practitioner to be in an incurable or a vegetative/coma state (and it is medically impossible to awaken them) shall be refused euthanasia or assisted suicide.

#### **SECTION 4. ABOLISHMENT OF CURRENT ANTI-EUTHANASIA LEGISLATION**

All laws that make euthanasia, mercy killing, assisted suicide, or anything defined along with the terms of euthanasia, shall be abolished and made obsolete. Any trained medical professional or practitioner shall not be able to withhold euthanasia, mercy killing, assisted suicide, or anything defined along with the terms of euthanasia, given that the patient wants it and it is proved medically impossible to alleviate the pain or wake up from the coma or vegetative state.
