Whereas, The Senate recognizes that immigrants and refugees are often in their times of direst need when coming to The United States of America;

Whereas, The Senate recognizes that The United States of America is a great nation made stronger by including and inviting a breadth of opinions, perspectives, and lived experiences;

Whereas, The Senate recognizes the refugee crises which are presently occurring across the globe, including, but not limited to those in Syria, Ukraine, Ethiopia, Afghanistan, and Sudan; and

Whereas, The Senate recognizes the growing count of climate refugees and the possibility for an unprecedented growth in future climate refugees; Therefore, be it

Resolved that The Senate -

- (1) Affirms its commitment to protecting refugees in their journeys to the United States of America, their processes in relocation, and in their new lives in this great nation,
- (2) Encourages the development of policies dedicated to enacting the aforementioned commitment and putting actions to words,
- (3) Will take steps in the following session of Congress to address issues relating to refugee resettlement and immigration through legislation.
