RESOLUTION

Recognizing The National Aeronautics and Space Administration of their service to the American people and way of life and to encourage the effort of the future Mars Missions to further the reach of mankind and the understanding of the known universe.

SECTION 2.

Whereas the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) was primarily designed to oversee U.S. space exploration and aeronautics research.

Whereas the Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL) has taken leadership coordinating efforts to build and design space craft even with other foreign partners;

Whereas NASA provides the world with astronauts in orbit to perform scientific research for the betterment of our quality of life.

Whereas there is no way of performing any task or having the kind of life Americans enjoy today if it were not for the satellites NASA send up to orbit; and

Whereas NASA's Education Office helps teachers to prepare the students who will be the engineers, scientists, and astronauts of the future, being the pioneers who will continue the exploration of the solar system and universe especially through NASA's newest mission on getting mankind to Mars;

Resolved, that the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA), on behalf of its members

(1) supports even more contractors for aid in space missions in hope of also stimulated business;

(2) provides a friendly foreign connection to other space-faring countries of the world;

(3) request more funding from the Treasury in an appropriate amount deemed justifiable from a majority of the Senate thereof for the hopes of getting man to Mars; and

(4) continues inspiring the youth and next generation of Americans into careers that further the reach and understanding of mankind.
