IN THE SENATE OF THE AMERICAN LEGION BOYS NATION

Mr. Kopecky of Georgia introduced the following bill;

A BILL

The goal of the Bill is to Increase funding to Fish and Wildlife departments across the nation. The end hope is that this increase in funding lends to better preservation of public land for Sporting and recreation.

Be it enacted by The American Legion Boys Nation Senate assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "The American Outdoors Act".

SECTION 2. This law hereby calls for the delegation of funds from the treasury, which are not currently appropriated by the end of the budget year, to the US Fish & Wildlife Service.

1. These funds shall not exceed (25%) of the budget preset for the year
2. These funds shall be delegated (85%) to game management

3. These funds shall be delegated (13%) to additional pay for employees
4. These funds shall remain (2%) in excess for any minuscule needs unforeseen
5. These funds should ensure the continuation of the American sporting life, and increase revenue to be used for the protection of America's Natural Resources
