RESOLUTION

Filibustering has been a strategy on both ends of the political spectrum to waste time on the floor. Often seen as "political games", filibustering is not a productive use of time in the Senate and therefore should be restricted.

Whereas the filibuster is defined to prolong debate and to delay or prevent vote on a bill;

Whereas filibustering is unproductive and prolongs urgent national priorities;

Whereas the filibuster gives disproportionate power to the minority of senators over the majority of senators;

Whereas filibustering has increased bipartisanship as opposing parties use filibusters to block key legislation favored by the other political party;

Whereas restricting filibustering would bring more public trust to the Senate;

Whereas the "cloture rule" requires 60 votes to end debate making it difficult to prevent filibustering;

Whereas overusing the filibuster undermines democracy and impedes the ability of elected representatives to speak on the floor; Now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Senate -

(1) restrict the use of filibustering in the Senate.
