An act to give free compressed air at all gas stations in the USA.

IN THE SENATE OF THE AMERICAN LEGION BOYS NATION

Mr. Rodriguez of New Mexico introduced the following bill;

A BILL

An act to give free compressed air at all gas stations in the USA.

Be it enacted by The American Legion Boys Nation Senate assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "The Fair Air Act".

SECTION 2. Purpose

This section is directed for customer safety, convenience, and quality of life by mandating that gas stations provide FREE access to compressed air strictly for tire inflation.

SECTION 2.1 Requirements

a) All gas stations across the nation will be required to install and maintain

fully functional compressed air stations within the gas stations premises.

b) The Compressed air stations shall now be referred to as "Air Stations"

c) The Air stations shall be easily accessible to those in need of compressed air and shall be visible and prominent for easy access.

SECTION 2.2 Availability

a) All gas station staff shall be in charge of ensuring that the Air stations are available at the same operating hours of the gas pumps, without any charge or payment needed from the customers.

b) The Air Stations WILL be equipped with the proper and standard nozzles for all common tire valve types letting customers fill their tires with ease.

c) Customers are seen as entitled to compressed air for their tires for safety, convenience, and necessary to the proper function, and safety of their vehicle.

SECTION 3. Compliance, Maintenance, and Safety

a) Gas station employees will perform regular inspections of the Air Stations to make sure that they are in proper working order.

b) Any errors, defects, or malfunctions shall be reported and promptly repaired to maintain the availability of the Air Stations to customers.

SECTION 3.1 Customer Complaints

a) Customers are entitled to submit complaints to their local consumer

protection agency or their respective regulatory body if they come across a malfunctioning or inaccessible Air Station.

b) Penalties will be determined by the respectful regulating body if gas station operators are found to be in violation of the provisions defined in this bill.

SECTION 4. Awareness and Education

a) Public Notice: Gas Station operators will be required to display signage informing the public of the new Air stations available.

b) Signage will need to be provided on all Air Stations detailing the safe operation and care of the Air Stations to all who use the Air Stations.

c) public service announcements, driving schools, and online resources shall be required to campaign on proper tire maintenance.

SECTION 5. Effective Date

This act shall take effect on January 1, 2024
