Mr. Martinez Valcher of Nevada introduced the following bill;

A BILL

Illegal immigrants who have a college degree or are currently enrolled in college become priority in the application process for American citizenship.

Be it enacted by The American Legion Boys Nation Senate assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "Illegal Immigrant Education Citizenship Act".

SECTION 2. CITIZENSHIP PRIORITY FOR COLLEGE-EDUCATED ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS.

There is hereby priority for citizenship application and security from deportation granted to all illegal immigrants: people who are living or working within the United States without legal permission; currently enrolled in college or who have a degree which consists of an associate or higher-

(1) This granted priority and security will begin when an illegal immigrant applies for college and provides documentation proving this application to the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service;

- (2) All illegal immigrants that are enrolled in college must continue until earning their degree or else they risk losing the priority and security mentioned above;
- (3) All illegal immigrants that drop out are given one year's time to re-enroll in a college and must provide documentation confirming re-enrollment;
- (4) All illegal immigrants who are awaiting news about their application status shall be granted security, during the allotted time provided by the college, in which they expect to receive the news.
