## A BILL

The protection of prosecuted parties against Capital Punishment Act, to enforce justice and Prosperity in our nation.

*Be it enacted by The American Legion Boys Nation Senate assembled,*

### **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

This Act may be cited as the "The Abolition of Capital Punishment Act".

### **SECTION 2. Definitions-**

(A)-For the purpose of this legislation the term Capital Punishment shall be defined as the state Sanctioned killing of a prosecuted party as a means of pursuing justice in the legal system.

(B)-For the purpose of this legislature the term "Life without Parole" shall de defined as the permanent imprisonment of a prosecuted party with no opportunity of parole unless the crimes for which the prosecuted party has been convicted is deemed an unjust ruling.

### **SECTION 3. Purpose-**

The purpose of this bill is to prevent any Capital Punishment against prosecuted parties throughout, in an attempt to preserve justice and righteousness for our people.

### **SECTION 4. Body-**

(A)After the enactment of this Bill, Capital Punishment will not be issued as a punishment for any crime at any level of government.

(B)If the legal system deems capital punishment fit for the crime that a party commits, life without parole shall instead be enacted.

### **SECTION 5. Repeal Clause**

All acts or parts of acts in conflict are hereby repealed.

### **SECTION 6. Effective Dates**

This Bill shall go in effect 90 days after receiving all qualifications to be turned into law.
